How Create multiple site on a single dashboard

To enable the Network Setup menu item, you must first enable multisite in the **wp-config.php** file.

Open up wp-config.php and add this line **above** where it says /* That's all, stop editing! Happy blogging. */. If it doesn't say that anywhere, then add the line somewhere above the first line that begins with require or include:

Installing a Network

The previous step enables the **Network Setup** item in your **Tools menu**. Use that menu item to go to the **Network Setup** screen.



You may asked to deactivate your plugins before staring installation!

Then you can install the network :



Follow the given steps in the installation page :

1- Step 1:

Add the following to your wp-config.php file in C:/wamp64/www/wp/ **above** the line reading /* That's all, stop editing! Happy blogging. */:

define('MULTISITE', true); define('SUBDOMAIN_INSTALL', false); define('DOMAIN_CURRENT_SITE', 'localhost'); define('PATH_CURRENT_SITE', '/wp/'); define('SITE_ID_CURRENT_SITE', 1); define('BLOG_ID_CURRENT_SITE', 1);

2- Step 2:

Add the following to your .htaccess file in C:/wamp64/www/wp/, **replacing** other WordPress rules: RewriteEngine On RewriteBase /wp/ RewriteRule ^index\.php\$ - [L] # add a trailing slash to /wp-admin RewriteRule ^([_0-9a-zA-Z-]+/)?wp-admin\$ \$1wp-admin/ [R=301,L] RewriteCond % {REQUEST_FILENAME} -f [OR] RewriteCond % {REQUEST_FILENAME} -d RewriteRule ^ - [L] RewriteRule ^ - [L] RewriteRule ^([_0-9a-zA-Z-]+/)?(wp-(content|admin|includes).*) \$2 [L] RewriteRule ^([_0-9a-zA-Z-]+/)?(.*\.php)\$ \$2 [L] RewriteRule _ index.php [L]

Once you complete these steps, your network is enabled and configured. You will have to log in again. <u>Log In</u>
